

RECREATIONAL REFEREE COURSE INFORMATION

The Recreational Referee course takes approximately 8 hours consisting of 4 hours in the classroom and 4 hours on the field. Students completing the Recreational Referee course are qualified to center games through U-14. The course will be held Sunday, August 15 from Noon AM to 8:00PM in the Castine Center at Pelican Park. The course fee is \$50. Make checks payable to MSC. Any person 12 years or older may attend. The course fee is refundable after reffing 5 MSC games.

PRE-REGISTRATION INCLUDING PAYMENT IS REQUIRED FOR THIS COURSE. THERE WILL BE A LIMIT OF 40 PARTICIPANTS.

BRIDGE REFEREE COURSE INFORMATION

The bridge course is a continuation of the recreational referee course and takes approximately 8 hours of classroom training. Students completing the Bridge Referee course are qualified to center games of all age groups. The course will be held Sunday, August 22, 2010, noon to 8:00 PM at the MSC office. The course fee is \$50. Make checks payable to MSC. Any person 14 years or older may attend. The course fee is refundable after reffing 5 MSC games.

PRE-REGISTRATION INCLUDING PAYMENT IS REQUIRED FOR THIS COURSE. THERE WILL BE A LIMIT OF 25 PARTICIPANTS.
